STATE FINALISTS! SEASON FINISH 2005-2006 BOYS BASKETBALL TEAM: 19-1

The 2005-2006 Sacred Heart basketball team became only the third in the school's history to reach the State Championship game before falling to Wyoming Tri-Unity Christian. The 1967 and 1976 squads won the Championship game. The team finished with 25 wins and 2 losses. **Pat Theisen** was the team's leading scorer and gained All State status for his efforts. Pat is the son of **Andy '78** and **Julie Flannery Theisen '78** (and grandson of **Bob Theisen '50**, GGS of **Tom Carey '23** and GGS of **Nellie Garvin Carey '97!**). Other alumni offspring on the team included **Dave Martin** (Steve '71), **Caleb Simons** (Dan '70) and **Jacob Thering** (Bob '76). The team captured the eleventh Regional Championship in history, the last eight featured members of the **John and Evelyn Simons** family: 1967 (Mark), 1968 (Mark), 1969 (Dan), 1970 (Dan), 1975 (Dave), 1980 (Andy), 2005 (Caleb) and 2006 (Caleb). Coincidentally, the 1934 team also included a Simons, Robert, but no relation to the recent Simons group.

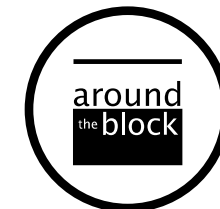
