## TUITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Many Alumni received a letter from the Sacred Heart Parish office regarding the "Building on Faith" tuition assistance program for the Academy. The flyer was accompanied by an appeal letter from Bret Hyble, the Director of Development for the Parish and Academy. Mr. Hyble's job description is to help financially support the operations at Sacred Heart.

When the current Alumni Association was formed in 1976 we pledged that it was not intended to be a fund raising organization. Over these past 33 years our mailing list had only been shared with the Sacred Heart Academy Foundation for their annual fall appeal and the Alumni Association encourages support of that institution. The Association has agreed in principle to providing the mailing list to the Parish for periodic communications with Alumni.

\$35,000 is in the school budget for tuition assistance but requests for assistance totaled \$80,000 last year. The present campaign is attempting to provide additional monies for the funds by encouraging tax deductible donations to cover a day, a week, a month or a year for a family in need.
