Our Mission: Sacred Heart Academy, a Catholic school founded in 1889, is committed to the mission of Jesus Christ. With our families and faith community, we provide a balanced curriculum to strengthen mind, body, and spirit so each student fulfills God's purpose.

Student Engagement/Curriculum: Strategies will be utilized to increase student engagement by incorporating best-practice teaching methods which promote active learning, implementing curriculum maps for all subject areas DK-12, and providing current professional development in lesson planning.

School Culture: The school culture strategy has been created to reduce absenteeism at Sacred Heart Academy by reviewing and revising the current attendance policy and communicating it to students and parents, consistently enforcing rules and policies, and implementing character development/Christian values program.

Finance/Facilities: In the area of finance/facilities, a strategy has been implemented to improve and enhance STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) instruction. In addition, a comprehensive development plan will be created to address other financial needs of the school. A deferred maintenance plan will be developed to provide updates to the building and technology, as needed. Teacher retention during their first five years of employment at Sacred Heart Academy has been a challenge. A strategy has been developed to address all teacher salaries over the next three years.
