Gerald "Jerry" McDonald was born May 20, 1932 in Mt. Pleasant, the son of Fred and Lucille (Thering) McDonald. Jerry was a 1950 graduate of Sacred Heart Academy. He proudly served in the U.S. Army from 1953 to 1954, during the Korean War. He married Marian Wehl in 1957 at Sacred Heart Church, and they raised five children who also graduated from SHA: Judy, Jeff, Steve, Tim and Pat.

Jerry was employed by Norm Prior Service, Roosevelt Refinery, and then Alma Total Petroleum and Total Pipeline where he worked for 39 years. He was a member of Sacred Heart Church, where he served as a usher. Jerry also served as a Trustee of the Sacred Heart Academy Foundation.

He enjoyed gardening, lawn work, playing cards and visiting friends, but by far, what was most important to him was his family. Watching his kids' activities growing up, and witnessing their sporting events, then enjoying the grandchildren, their events and family get-togethers, is what made him most proud and happy. He left a legacy rooted in faith, family, and service to country.

The Gerald McDonald Memorial Scholarship was established by the SHA Foundation to commemorate Jerry's service and devotion to Sacred Heart Academy and mission of the SHA Foundation. Interest from the endowed fund is given each year in tuition assistance to help families attend SHA.
