What is the cost of lunch?

Lunch is \$3 for students. Several ala carte choices at varying prices are available each day. Parents who do not want their child to purchase ala carte items should inform the office. Children who bring their own lunch may purchase milk for \$0.50.

Is free and reduced lunch available?

Sacred Heart Academy participates in the National School Lunch Program. Free and reduced lunch forms are available at the elementary office (989-773-9530). Utmost confidentiality is maintained regarding these forms, and there is never reference made to children regarding free and reduced lunches. It should be noted that only a regular lunch is covered under the free and reduced program, meaning that children who purchase ala carte items will be charged the corresponding prices.

How do I pay for lunches?

Each family has a lunch account. Beginning with the 2018-19 school year, parents must preload their lunch account by logging into Parentsweb. Details are being worked out and will be shared with parents before school starts on August 27, 2018.

Is the kitchen inspected for health and food safety?

The health department conducts two to three unannounced inspections each year. These inspections are required to maintain the license from the health department to run the kitchen, and SHA does consistently very well with these inspections. Additionally, the State of Michigan conducts an extensive examination of the program at least every 5 years.

What nutrition guidelines are followed daily?

SHA abides by the nutrition guidelines as set forth in the national school lunch program.
