




FRESHMAN VOLLEYBALL

The JV Girls Basketball Team was on fire this year! The girls gave their all and became closer not only as a team but as friends. Everyone really grew as players. It was a blast!











CROSS COUNTRY

The March For Life gives students the opportunity to learn about an important, national issue. It also gives students the experience of being in a big city and standing up for something important.






















