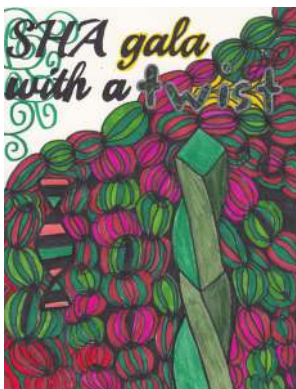

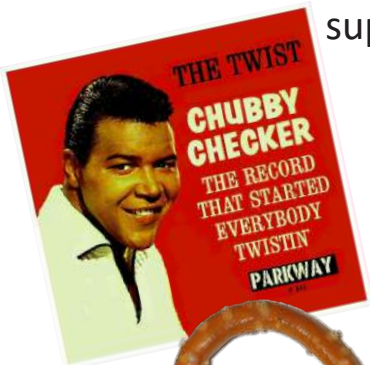

Dear Parents, Patrons, and Friends of Sacred Heart Academy,

We would like to welcome all of you to SHAgala 2021. This is our biggest fundraising event of the year. This is our 27th SHAgala event which raises money for our school. This year's theme is "*SHAgala With a Twist*".

When I think of our theme, what immediately comes to mind is a dance called "The Twist". It is an American pop song written and originally released in 1958 by Hank Ballard and the Midnighters as a B-side to "Teardrops on your Letter". Ballard's version was a moderate hit, peaking at number 28 on Billboard's Top 100.

In July 1960, Chubby Checker released his version of "The Twist". His song gave birth to the Twist dance craze. His single became a hit, reaching number one on the Billboard charts. Chubby Checker performed the Twist for the first time in front of a live audience at The Rainbow Club in Wildwood, New Jersey. Just weeks later, on August 6, 1960, the song became a national sensation when he performed it on Dick Clark's American Bandstand. In 1961 and '62, the "Twist" craze caught on with high society. Sightings of celebrities doing the dance made the song a hit with adults. Soon there were long lines at The Peppermint Club in New York, the most popular twisting spot. The song and dance were a turning point for adult acceptance of Rock 'n' Roll music.

The word twist has many varied definitions and meanings. A priest friend of mine typically orders a perfect Manhattan with a twist, no cherries or cherry juice. We use a corkscrew to twist the cork out of a wine bottle. Someone might misquote you and twist your words. We twist our heads to turn to one side or the other. A baseball pitcher twists his arm in order to throw a curveball.

Our 2021 SHAgala is twisted this year, due to the COVID-19 virus, putting a crimp in the usual way we celebrate. However, the prizes for the cash raffle are the same, and you will see many of the most popular auction items, as presented in past events.

A special thank you for our invaluable committee who made the virtual event possible thanks to their creativity. Thank you for all the people of Sacred Heart Academy who make Catholic education possible for our families. And thank you to all the SHAgala 2021 participants who are helping our students and teachers tremendously. Because of COVID, we had to "twist" a little. Hopefully, this event will be a "craze" for the Academy this year.

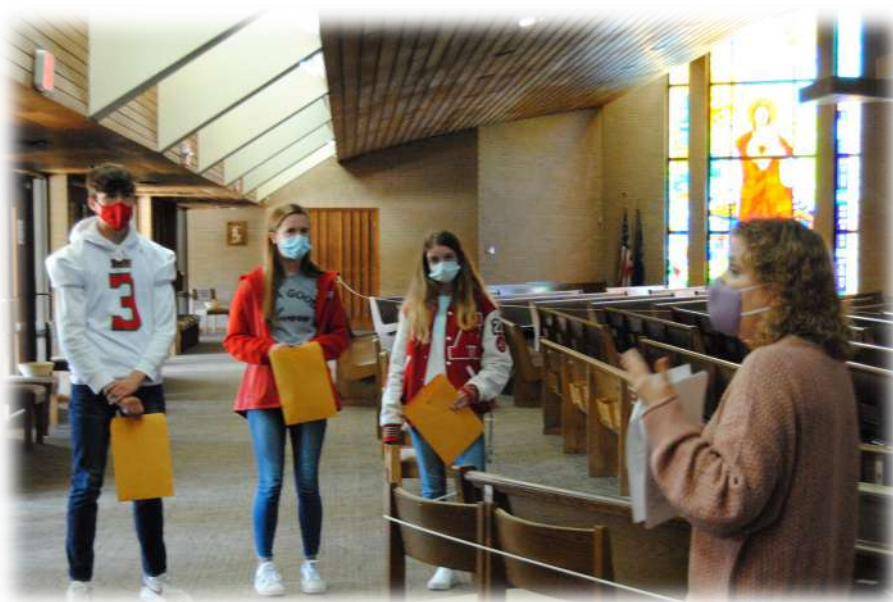
