

Welcome, Supporters of Catholic School Education at Sacred Heart Academy:

We would like to salute Bishop Gruss who is joining us for this wonderful event. Also, a special welcome to those who are attending this gala experience for the first time, and all who are regular attendees. Thank you for participating in our 30th annual dinner and auction to benefit our school.

Our theme for this years' SHAgala is "A Black and White Affair".

This article appeared in a newspaper a few years ago, "Why do referees wear Black and White Stripes?"

Before sport referees donned the zebra stripes we know so well today, many showed up to games in some variation of this spiffy dress: white dress shirt and slacks, black bow tie, and white flat cap.

The uniforms made officials seem official, but it wasn't quite distinct enough to set them apart from the players during fast-paced games. When one of the teams was also wearing white, things could get confusing. An Eastern Michigan student named Lloyd W. Olds experienced this issue firsthand while officiating high school basketball games in 1914. "The referee often looked very much like a player, so the lads often threw the ball to me or bounced it off my head," he later recalled.

By 1920, Olds had started officiating football in the area as well. After a quarterback from a white clad team accidentally passed him the ball during a game, Olds finally decided he was long overdue for a costume change. He collaborated with an Ann Arbor sports shop owner named George Mae on a knit shirt with black and white vertical stripes, which he wore for the first time in 1921. It wasn't an immediate success. Fans actually booed him from the stands. "It took plenty of ribbing when I first appeared in it," Olds said, "But the idea caught on among both basketball and football officials."

Olds went on to become something of an athletic legend at Eastern Michigan University. He coached the university's track and cross-country teams for 25 years, served as an assistant track coach for the U.S. Olympic team in 1932 and 1936, and developed EMU's intramural program into a vibrant part of campus life. Black and white stripes are now worn by referees in football, basketball, hockey, lacrosse, wrestling, and more.

The SHAgala committee has worked hard to display an assortment of items for you to purchase and to enjoy for yourself or for your family. 

It is only fitting to recognize our beloved Fr. Don at SHAgala time. His passing last year brought so many together, recalling fond memories of his time at Sacred Heart Academy and Sacred Heart Parish, as a religion teacher, a bus driver, a priest, and a forever friend to everyone.

Fr. Don was always supportive of SHAgala. He was at Sacred Heart when the first dinner auction was hosted at the school in 1994, and even attended some of the the St. Patrick's Day events featuring Irish Stew and green beer which eventually became SHAgala as we know it today. Always one to lend others a hand, or help in any way he could, Fr. Don also actively participated in the success of SHAgala. One year he was part of a Live Auction package which included fun at an amusement place called Kokomo's and Fr. Don would transport the group there in the SHA bus. He drove the football players to the Upper Peninsula back and forth to camp each summer, and faithfully transported students to retreat locations as well.
