- **Live Auction:** Opens Wednesday, February 11 at 12:00 Noon for PREVIEW ONLY and will remain in PREVIEW mode until Saturday, February 14 at approximately 7:45 p.m. when the auction happens at the **live venue only**. *Only those who have purchased tickets to the on-site event are able to bid on Live Auction items.*
- All sales are final and there are no exchanges or refunds.
- Unless otherwise specified, all auction items and services must be used within one year. Please check bearer letters and/or certificates for any exceptions to this expiration date.
- Payment for the item(s) by the successful bidder can be made one of two ways:
  1. You may charge the amount to the credit card you have on file with BidPal the evening of the auction; or
  2. You may elect to make payment with cash or check directly to SHAgala when you pick up your item(s).

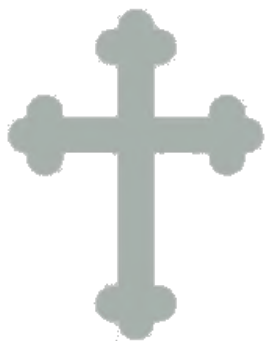

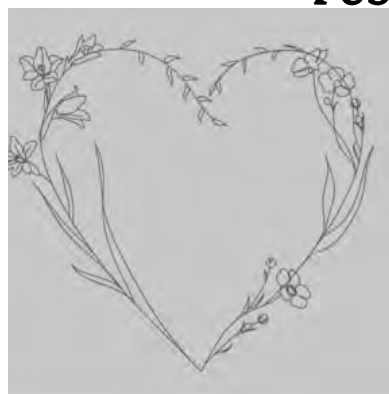
