

Sacred Heart Academy – Scrip Program

What is Scrip?

Scrip is a Tuition Reduction Program. You purchase gift cards, use them for shopping at local and national merchants and receive a discount which is **applied to your tuition account** each spring for the upcoming year's fees. It's easy, simple and a great way to put a dent in your tuition, doing something you already do: shop, eat and buy gas! Sacred Heart purchases Scrip at a discount and re-sells the certificates for face value. The bulk of the discount - from 2 to 15% or more - is retained by you and Sacred Heart as revenue. For example, if you purchase a \$100 Home Depot card, you pay \$100. Home Depot has a discounted rate of 3%, Sacred Heart pays only \$97 for the \$100 gift card and you receive a \$100 Home Depot card. The 3% discount equals \$3. You receive 80% of that and Sacred Heart receive 20%. Stop by the Parish office or visit <https://shop.shopwithscrip.com/Login> to register. Is there an App for that?



Yes! **The Raise Right App** is available for both Apple and Android devices. Download to your device and register. Once signed up, you can order gift cards (to be sent directly to your home or the Parish Office and/or e-gift cards that loads to the app within minutes for immediate use.

What do I need to start purchasing gift cards?

When enrolling in the Scrip program via computer or app, you will need the **SHA Scrip enrollment code: E491B5L6343** Next, create login information and add the student's name you wish to apply your reimbursements. From there you will add your payment type. Credit card or linking your bank account is an option. It is recommended to link your banking information directly (or there is a manual option if preferred) to make the instant e-gift cards quick and easy.

Does using Scrip really add up?



Yes! Using the Scrip Program via the Raise Right App can add up when you use it regularly for the things you already plan on purchasing in your daily lives like gas, groceries, restaurants, home improvements and travel. Friends and family members can sign up on behalf of your student too!
